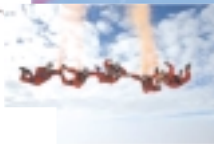

Many buses travel to Heaton Park, including 56, 59, 64, 64A, 135, 137, 138, 150, 151, 484, 495. Please check with GMPTC for up to date information and an interactive journey planner by Metrolink Tram

The nearest Metrolink tram station is Heaton Park, and is situated at a pedestrian entrance to the park. Trams run regularly from the city centre and other destinations.

The three main vehicular entrances are St Margaret's Rd, Smithy Lodge and Sheepfoot Lane entrances.
